Responsible for the preparation of project budget to be submitted to Sr. Mechanical Engineer and then to the General Manager for approval. Assist the Sr. Mechanical Engineer in the overall planning and directing of all mechanical work activities in coordination with other trades namely; Civil and Electrical Work including the review of the projects to be undertaken such as designs, review of material specifications, project scheduling, completion dates, job designation of personnel for specific scope of work in the project. This includes project contract review and finalization of subcontractors contracts. Checking of all final project design, shop drawings based on the required specifications, revisions if any, including project budget, materials/equipment and manpower schedule required in the project.
